For the past 18 months much of the attention of the Joint National Committee (JNC) has been diverted to the organisation of the ISGF Western Europe Sub-Region Gathering, behind that the JNC has continued to address the usual business of administering NSGF UK. Regular JNC meetings have taken place, including the 5th Annual General Meeting held on 4th April 2017 in Pontesbury and the 6th Annual General Meeting held on 13th May in Halifax (see report below) where the NSGF Chairman reported as follows:

The past 12 months have been quite eventful for NSGF UK and for both component associations, (B-P Guild & SAGF) working to support Scouting, Guiding their local communities and with their respective International Projects. NSGF UK have also contributed to the World Chairman's appeal for the provision of tents for the South Sudanese refugees in living in North West Uganda. Members attended the ISGF World Conference in Bali and carried the proxy vote for NSGF Uganda. Twinning has since taken place between NSGF UK & NSGF Uganda.

The Joint National Committee of the NSGF UK held its Annual General Meeting at The Crown Imperial Hotel, Halifax at 11am on Sunday 13th May 2018. Chair: Margaret Apologies were received from Jannette Kenworthy, Member, who was attending the Trefoil Guild, South-West Region meeting. The usual AGM business was quickly completed, with the approval of the Annual Report (already sent to the World Bureau) and the Financial Report. It was agreed to leave the membership fee for 2019 at £3.20.

Five members were nominated onto the JNC, three from the B-P Guild and two from SAGF, with a third SAGF member to be advised before the next JNC meeting. The Chair summed up the past year as above and finished his remarks with: Finally, I must say a special thank you to Jane Wardropper, Peter Short, & Liz Aveston for their work, serving on the JNC Committee for the last 6 years.
