You are all invited to join us at our **AGM** which will take place on **Saturday 14th May 2016**.

The meeting will be at **11am** in the **Central Shrewsbury Baptist Church Hall**, Claremont St, SY1 1QG, in the centre of the town.

Shrewsbury, the county town of Shropshire, is in a loop in the River Severn. A mediaeval town, steeped in history and birth place of Charles Darwin, it offers a wide variety of individual shops, markets, museums and interesting activities in and around the centre. There are town trails and a river cruise which we will arrange if requested.

It is easily accessible by both road and rail and, if you wish to stay longer and see more, ideally situated to explore:-

- World Heritage sites of the Ironbridge Gorge Museum and the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.
- Historic Ludlow.
- Much Wenlock (birth place of the modern Olympic games).
- Wroxeter Roman City.
- National Trust properties - Attingham Park and Powys Castle.
- Carding Mill Valley and the Long Mynd.
- English heritage properties – Stokesay Castle and Haughmond Abbey.
- Broneirion – Welsh Guide HQ and training centre.

Accommodation.

Please book your own accommodation, there are many hotels in the town covering a wide price range, however for a group we would recommend the **Premier Inn, Smithfield Rd** as probably being the most convenient. (Cheapest to book through an internet hotel booking site)

It is newly built, next door to the bus station and over the road from the train station.

There is also a highly recommended caravan and motorhome **Touring Park** adjacent to the Oxon Park and Ride bus park, therefore easily accessible to the town centre.

Activities will be arranged in Shrewsbury on the Saturday and programmes will be arranged for Sunday, Monday and Tuesday when we know numbers and where members would like to go.
