

Cruising Denmark • 4 days • 3 nights

On this 4-day tour we will get a good impression of what Denmark offers in terms of nature and history, while meeting fellowship members from several local fellowships. We ride on a comfortable tourist coach





and stay in 3- and 4-star hotels. Our professional tour guide, Lily, who is also a scout and fellowship member, accompanies us on the whole trip while guiding in English.

Day 1: Thursday 3 August 2023 North Jutland

After breakfast, where we pack our own lunch, we board the comfortable coach and head north along the North Sea – all the way to the northernmost tip: Skagen.

Here we enjoy our packed lunch before being taken by the tractor train "Sandormen" all the way to the tip, where Denmark ends and the two seas Skagerrak and Kattegat meet. Standing out in the shallows with a leg in each sea is a very special experience.


Afterwards we drive to Sæby south of Frederikshavn, where the fellowship members are ready to receive us at the manor Sæbygaard, which has an exciting history, and where medieval dinner is served in the knight's hall.

Day 2: Friday 4 August 2023 From North to Central Jutland


After enjoying the hotel breakfast, we board the bus and head south through Jutland. There are appropriate breaks along the way, and at lunchtime we arrive in Kolding. Here the Kolding fellowships are ready to welcome us with typical Danish hospitality and lunch.

After lunch we drive to Kongernes Jelling – Home of the Viking Kings (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) where we visit the two Jelling stones and the museum that explains why the rune stones are called Denmark's birth certificate and Denmark's baptism certificate.

The day ends in Vejle, where you can take a walk on the new harbour front and see "Bølgen" – a sculptural residential building with modern homes – and "Fjordenhus", designed by the famous Danish-Icelandic artist Olafur Eliasson.

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We enjoy breakfast at the hotel and board the bus for Copenhagen.

On the way we stop in Odense, where the famous poet Hans Christian Andersen was born and raised. In connection with his birthplace, a brand new museum has been created where, wearing a headset, you can experience the adventurous life of the poet in your own language. You get an insight into the artist's universe; from the son of a poor shoemaker to a celebrity who never achieved his dream of true love.

From the world of fairy tales we drive the short way to "Gildehuset" in Odense, where the Odense fellowships are ready with a nice lunch.

Then we settle into the coach and drive the rest of the way to Copenhagen, where the last evening meal of the tour is enjoyed with local fellowship members.

We stay at a hotel in Copenhagen.







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Day 4: Sunday 6 August 2023 Capital and return journey:

After breakfast at the hotel, we check out and the rest of the day is free (the hotel has luggage storage facilities).

Lily offers a city walk in central Copenhagen, passing by the classic tourist attractions, but you can also choose to go on an excursion on your own.

Maybe at dinner last night you made a new friend who wants to show you around, or you fancy hiring a bike and riding along the harbour, where there's a brand new promenade with lidos, kayak hire and lots of other activities.

You can also visit some of our interesting museums. Lily and the hotel reception can help find your way. They also assist with transport to Copenhagen Central Station and the airport.

The tour costs DKK $4,745/ \in 633$ for a shared double room. Extra for single room is DKK 795 / \in 106. The tour will be carried out if the number of participants is min. 30. The maximum number is 50.

The price includes 3 daily meals and entrance fees to all mentioned sights.

Lunch on the first day is packed lunch, all other meals are at the hotel or with local fellowship members. Last meal included is breakfast at the hotel on day 4.

Any return journey to Ranum is not included in the price.

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
